We have booked a Moore class trip to a **Living Land at Kent Showground on Thursday 1st May.**

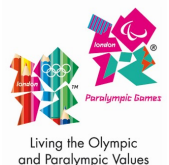
The **Living Land** is a free, one-day event aimed at educating Years 3 and 4 in farming, agriculture, horticulture and the countryside with approximately 2,700 children attending from schools all over Kent.

We will be travelling there and back by minibus. We have been asked to arrive at the showground by 9:10am with our first activity at 9:30am. So we will need to leave school by 8:20am. The event finishes at 2:10pm so we hope to be back at school by the end of the school day.

WEATHER...

Children should come prepared with strong footwear **whatever the weather**; ideally wellies or trainers, not sandals. If it is raining, waterproof clothing is advised and sunscreen and a sunhat if the sun is shining. Some activities are outdoors. School uniform and school caps must be worn please.

FOOD TASTING...

Please be aware that children will have the opportunity to taste different types of food. Parents or guardians should advise teachers of any intolerances or allergies that a child may have.

HAND WASHING FACILITIES...

Children are able to touch animals at the Living Land. It is important that **everyone** washes their hands with soap and water after touching animals and before eating. There are portable hand washing stations that will be signposted from the animal areas.

MONEY...

Children do **NOT** need to bring any money to the event as there is nothing for sale.

The cost of this trip will be £2 to cover the cost of the transport. All payments must be made online at www.scopay.com/shorehamvillage

You are required to tick the consent box for this event, this will give permission for your child to attend and for the teacher in charge of the party to give consent on your behalf for any urgent medical treatment, including anaesthetic to be given.

Please register by **Wednesday 23rd April**. If we do not hear from you by this date then we will assume that your child is not able to participate.

We will be looking for a volunteer to help with this trip so please indicate on the form if you would be able to.
