Dear Parents/Carers,

It is our school policy that all pupils wear Shoreham Village School's uniform when in school or representing the school in an organised event out of school hours. As well as being practical and smart wearing our uniform reinforces a positive learning environment, supports our ethos, instils pride and promotes a sense of community and a unified school spirit.

Below is a list of the uniform that pupils are expected to wear. Winter uniform should be worn for terms 2, 3 and 4 and summer uniform should be worn for terms 5, 6 and term 1

Summer Uniform

(beginning of summer term 5 to end autumn term 1 inclusive)

- yellow / white checked dress OR
- white polo shirt
- dark grey (not black, no embellishments) skirt/ shorts / trousers
- green school sweater/cardigan*
- white/ grey socks

Winter Uniform

(beginning of autumn term 2 to end spring Term 4 inclusive)

- white polo shirt
- dark grey (not black, no embellishments) skirt or trousers
- green school sweater/cardigan*
- white/ grey socks or grey tights
- plain black coat

Shoes

- Conventional black school shoes or plain black (no coloured logos) trainers
- Wellington boots are required

















PE Kit

All pupils should have a **named** PE kit which they will wear into school on the days they have PE.

- school PE bag* (clearly named)
- school green t-shirt* (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 only)
- school sports polo shirt* (Years 3-6 only)
- plain black shorts
- school black fleece*
- plain black jog pants
- plain black plimsolls or trainers, white socks.

Additional Notes:

All uniform should be clearly marked (marker or tape that will not wash out) with the child's name.

Please ensure that all coats have a sturdy hanging loop.

Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back and long fringes must be secured with a clip to keep hair off the face. This is for health and safety reasons.

Only simple stud earrings may be worn in school, and must be removed or taped prior to attending school on PE days for safety reasons.

Necklaces, bracelets, rings and other jewellery may not be worn.

Make-up, including nail varnish, may not be worn.

Our PTA (FOSS) run frequent 'nearly new' uniform sales; please contact the school office for further details. All lost property which does not have a name in it will be recycled at the end of each term.

An old shirt/overall for art/craft work is a good idea for keeping your child's clothes clean.

We hope that you will help your child to wear their uniform with pride and to ensure that they always look smart.
