Holiday Activity Programme, Sevenoaks

We are delighted to you invite your child to our Holiday Activity Programme, which will take place from 20 to 22 August 2024 at Sevenoaks School.

The three-day programme is designed to bring together highly engaged pupils from different schools and enable them to work collaboratively and build relationships with like-minded peers. The activities will be based at Sevenoaks School and staffed by experienced teachers from both our school and local primary schools. This summer we will be offering the following programmes:

For current Year 4 pupils:

Art, Music, Science or Sport

For current Year 5 pupils:

Drama, Mathematics, Music or Sport

For current Year 6 pupils:

Drama or Music

Each day will run from 9am to 3pm and, on the final day (Thursday 22 August), there will be a short Show & Tell to parents at 2.30pm.

The courses are designed for pupils who are highly interested by, and engaged in, that subject area. Please note that they will be doing the **same subject for all three days.**

Bookings are now open to all Year 4, 5 and 6 pupils from our partner primary schools. If you would like to register your child for one of our courses, please complete this [online booking form](#). The Holiday Activity Programme is always very popular and places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. If the course is fully booked, you will be placed on a waiting list and notified as soon as a space becomes available.

Sevenoaks School subsidises the project as part of its Primary Schools Partnership work. We can therefore offer the three-day programme at a total cost of £90. This includes a hot lunch in the Dining Hall each day, snacks and a t-shirt.

Once we have received your booking, we will be in touch to confirm payment details – payment
