### **Wimbledon Tennis Championships –Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July – Court 2**

We have been really lucky again this year to have been successful in the British Schools Tennis Association Wimbledon Ticket Ballot. This for many people is a once in a life-time opportunity to go to one of the major sporting events in this country and to have the opportunity to see some of the world's best tennis players.

We have been allocated just 8 pupil tickets and they will be accompanied by two adults. We are initially sending this letter to all pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6. It is important that pupils who attend will have a mature attitude towards the expected behaviour and etiquette involved in attending the Wimbledon Tennis Championships, such as sitting quietly during match play.

We would aim to catch the train from Shoreham to Sevenoaks and then travel by train to Waterloo East, then from Waterloo to Wimbledon and walk to the courts. The return journey would be to Sevenoaks to give us a wider range of times and trains.

As part of our aim is to broaden pupils' horizons and give them opportunities they may not otherwise have, we are able to fully fund this trip through the Sports Funding, so there will be no cost for the trip.
