Dear Parents/Carers

**Moore Class Trip to: The Science Museum – Flash, Bang, Wallop and 3D Antarctica – Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June.**

We have booked a Moore class trip to **The Science Museum, London on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June**, to support our learning from this term and for next term about Animals and Nutrition, Living things and their habitats and Changing State.

We will be catching the 9:45am train from Shoreham Station, going to Otford, to then catch the fast train to London Victoria and then catching the Underground for 2 stops to South Kensington Station, where it is a short walk to the museum. They will need to arrive promptly at school for the usual start of the school day. We will then be leaving school around 9:10 to get to the station in time.

In the Flash, Bang, Wallop Show, they will experience the wonder of science through exciting experiments and demos through a medley of experiments and demonstrations that are jam-packed with WOW moments. Flash, Bang, Wallop is jam-packed with thrilling experiments and demonstrations designed to help children find out about fire and explosions. While thinking about everyday applications of controlled explosions they'll demonstrate how energy is transferred through light, sound, heat and movement.

We should arrive at the museum by 11:00 am, giving us time to have a bit of lunch before the first show. The performance starts at 11:45am and lasts approximately 20 minutes. We will then have the rest of our lunch before watching the fully immersive, 3D Antarctica film in the IMAX cinema at the Science Museum, which starts at 12:30 and lasts 1 hour.

We will then return to London Victoria train station to catch the 14:55 train back to Otford. This is due to arrive at Otford station at 15:31. Please could you make arrangements to collect your child from Otford Station or if you are unable to do this yourself make arrangements with another family.

**We request that if you are unable to collect your child from Otford Station, that you make your own arrangements with another family to transport your child.** Please include the name of the person on form (if unknown please complete the form, enter TBC and inform office once arranged).

On the day, children will need to bring a small snack and a packed lunch plus their water bottle in a named small back pack to make it easier to carry, but please leave book bags at home. We are a nut free school so please ensure that you do not include any nuts. School uniform and **school caps** must be worn please.

**The cost of this trip will be £15.00 to cover the cost of the transport and admission. All payments must be made online at [www.scopay.com/shorehamvillage](http://www.scopay.com/shorehamvillage) by Wednesday 21st May.** If we do not hear from you by this date then we will assume that your child is not able to attend.

By completing the form you are giving permission for your child to attend and for the teacher in charge of the party to give consent on your behalf for any urgent medical treatment, including anaesthetic to be given.
