## 2026 Summer Term Curriculum Letter for Palmer Class

### Reading

We ask that reading records be handed into school each day so that they can be used as a means of communication with your child's class teacher. Please can I ask that you are reading with your child every day for around 10 minutes. Reading records will be checked daily, as they also provide a valuable link between home and school. When a child has read 100 times with accompanying signatures, they will be awarded a book of their choice.

### Homework

Homework and spellings will be handed out on **Friday** and collected in on a **Wednesday**. At the front of your child's homework book are a list of common exception words, it would be helpful if your child could be practising these. Please practise your child spellings with them, we no longer have in class spelling tests. The termly homework has 6 different tasks. You are welcome to do one a week or spend more time on one task. Please complete red tasks first. On a Friday afternoon, we have show and tell, this will only be for the topic homework they have completed.

### PE

PE will be on a Monday and Friday afternoon. Please ensure that your child is wearing their PE kit into school, which they will then wear throughout the day.

### General

Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle and that all personal clothing and items including wellington boots are labelled. Please provide additional sets of clothes and underwear to keep on your child's peg. Fruit is provided free of charge for all pupils, **however if children bring their own snack please could you ensure that it is a healthy one.**

## Year 1/2 Summer term 5 Curriculum Map

Mathematics	Length and height- measuring using objects, measuring in centimetres and metres, comparing length and height. Statistics- creating tally charts, block diagrams, pictograms and interpreting tables. Money- recognise and compare notes and coins, count money, make a pound and find change.
Literacy	Read write Inc. phonics and comprehension program Reading texts: Fantastically Great Women That Changed The World and Little People, Big Dreams. Writing: Non chronological report and Simple retelling of a story.
Science	Plants- where would we find them, what part of them grows underground, use the flower, trunk and leaves of plants to name the plant.
History	Where We Live Look at the history of our local area including the school, houses and famous people that lived here in the past.
RE	Islam: Does going to the mosque give Muslims a sense of belonging?
French	I will learn how to say I am hungry. I will learn the name of fruits and vegetables. I will read 'The Hungry Giant' story in French.
PSHE	Living in the wider world.
Music	Recognise the difference between different genres of music. Listen and recreate our own versions of folk music.
Art	Sculpting - Manipulate malleable materials in a variety of ways, learn about the works of Robert Bradford, review the work of sculptor Robert Bradford, Experiment with natural form to create sculptures.
Computing	Introduction to coding. We will be looking at creating events, algorithms, collision detection, using a timer and using sprites.
PE	Cricket and Swimming
