**THE PIONEER ACADEMY YEAR 6 ATHLETICS EVENT – WEDNESDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> JUNE – NORMAN PARK ATHLETICS GROUND, BROMLEY, BR2 9EF – 9:30AM – 3:00PM.**

We would like to invite your child to represent Shoreham Village School at The Pioneer Academy, Year 6 Athletics Event at Norman Park Athletics Ground on **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June starting at promptly at 10:00am, so we ask that you arrive at the venue for 9:30am.** We have been asked by TPA to have a combined team with Halstead School, due to the small number of students Halstead have in Year 6, and our Year 6's being the next smallest in the TPA schools.

Children are allowed to compete in maximum of 2 field events and 2 track events. With a team requiring at least 6 boys and 6 girls.

Field events: Long jump – Discuss (350g) – Vortex – 1kg Chest Push

Track events: 50m – 100m – 200m – 400m – 4x100m – 4x100m mixed.

Boys and girls will compete separately.

They will need to wear their school PE Kit and trainers and bring sun hats and sun cream. They will also need plenty to drink, including water, and some healthy snacks. We are a nut free school so please ensure that you do not include any nuts. Children will be on a designated green area outside the race track, all children must stay in the school area when not participating. Parents may spectate from the spectators area.

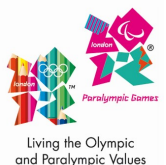
Please indicate when registering if you are able to volunteer to help supervise the children. Parents are welcome to stay and support the team as well and there is a café on site. We have been asked to remind parents / carers that there are to be no dogs, no smoking, no vaping and no alcohol. No photos of other children put on social media.

In order for us to take part we are looking for parental support in providing lifts. **We request that if you are unable to drop or collect your child at the venue that you make your own arrangements with another family to transport your child.** Please include the name of the person on form (if unknown please complete the form, enter TBC and inform office once arranged).

There is NO cost for this event but parents do need to advise us if they **do not** wish their child to participate.
